

# Physicians

## General Information

- Most routine Outpatient reports will be faxed twice a day, at 5:00 am and 1:00 pm.
- The headers and footers have a new look. Headers include our customer service number, fax number and Covenant's Web site address. We will have the patient's phone number when available for easy access for physician's offices to contact patients.
- We have added the patient's name to also be included at the bottom of the report
- The legend has been updated to one recommended by Cerner Corporation:
  - \* = corrected
  - @ = abnormal
  - C = critical
  - L = low
  - H = high
  - R = sent to reference lab
  - f = footnote
  - # = interpretive

## New Blood/Blood Product Orders

- Plt Pheresis, HLA matched
- Neonatal Platelet concentrate prompt – number of cc's required?
- Directed Donor Product

## Microbiology

- MRSA Culture (C MRSA) replaces Miscellaneous Culture (C MISC) for nasal screens.
- Group A Beta Strep Screen (Rapid Strep A) replaced Beta Strep Culture (C BETA).
  - When the Rapid Strep test is negative, it will reflex to a Group A culture (C GA).

## Chemistry

- New GFR reference range and change in calculation as per the National Kidney Disease Education Program recommendation.
- GFR Reference range: greater than or = to 60.
- We will no longer calculate a number greater than 60 for patients.

## Order Sets

- Some order sets that had included panels of tests will now display each test that was included in the panel. EXAMPLE: Type and Screen (TS) will now appear in an order set as ABORh and

Antibody Screen. Where possible Order panels have been inserted into Order Sets. Default settings are not available for an Order Panel used within an Order Set.

### **Body Fluids**

- All Body Fluid tests other than CSF have been incorporated into a generic Body Fluid order, such as Body Fluid Cell Count and Body Fluid Glucose, etc.
- Body Fluid Specific Gravity is NOT included in the Body Fluid Cell Count and must be ordered separately.

### **Physicians on EPIC in Office Setting**

- If you are a physician live on Epic in your office setting, the implementation of Cerner Millennium may uniquely affect you. Specifically, your individual preference lists containing lab orders may be affected and require modification. The eCovenant Ambulatory team will be contacting you with specific details.
